**PROPOSAL 10-1**

**A PROPOSAL TO CONVENE A CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF  
DRAFTING A GENERAL REVISION OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION**

Shall a convention of elected delegates be convened in 2011 to draft a general revision of the State Constitution for presentation to the state's voters for their approval or rejection?

**PROPOSAL 10-2**

**A PROPOSAL TO AMEND THE STATE CONSTITUTION TO PROHIBIT CERTAIN FELONS  
FROM HOLDING ELECTIVE OFFICE AND SPECIFIED TYPES OF PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT  
POSITIONS**

The proposed constitutional amendment would:

Make a person ineligible for election or appointment to any state or local elective office or to hold a position in public employment in this state that is policy-making or has discretionary authority over public assets, if:

- within the preceding 20 years, the person was convicted of a felony involving dishonesty, deceit, fraud, or a breach of the public trust; and
- the conviction was related to the person's official capacity while holding any elective office or position of employment in local, state or federal government.

Require the State Legislature to enact laws to implement the prohibition.

Should this proposal be adopted?

**MARION TOWNSHIP  
ROAD MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT  
MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

Shall the limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution on all taxable real and tangible personal property within the Township of Marion, Livingston County, Michigan, be increased for said Township in an amount not to exceed 1.0 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, Dec. 2011 to Dec. 2014, inclusive, to provide funds for the purpose of road maintenance and improvements, including dust control; and shall the Township levy such new additional millage for said purpose; the estimate of the revenue the Township of Marion will collect is an estimated \$340,000 in the first year the millage is levied?

**PUTNAM TOWNSHIP  
FIRE DEPARTMENT MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

This proposed new millage is intended to replace the fire equipment millage that will expire in 2010

Shall the 15-mill tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution on all taxable real and tangible personal property within the Township of Putnam, Livingston County, Michigan, be increased for said Township in an amount not to exceed .4695 mill (\$.4695 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of ten (10) years, 2011 to 2020 inclusive, to provide funds for purchasing, operating, equipping the fire department, constructing a new fire hall and for any other purpose authorized by law for fire department or fire service purposes; and shall the Township levy such new millage for said purpose; the estimate of the revenue the Township of Putnam will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Township in the 2011 calendar year is approximately \$152,158?

**DEXTER DISTRICT LIBRARY  
LIBRARY MILLAGE RENEWAL**

Shall the Dexter District Library, Counties of Washtenaw and Livingston, renew the previously voted increase in the tax limitation that expires in 2010 in an amount not to exceed .6925 mill (\$. 6925 on each \$1,000 dollars of taxable value) against all taxable real and tangible personal property within the Dexter District Library District for a period of six (6) years, 2011 to 2016, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law; and shall the Dexter District Library levy such millage for said purpose; the estimate of the revenue the Dexter District Library will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Library in the 2011 calendar year is approximately \$685,000? A portion of the revenue collected may be subject to capture by the Dexter Downtown Development Authority and the Scio Township Downtown Development Authority.
