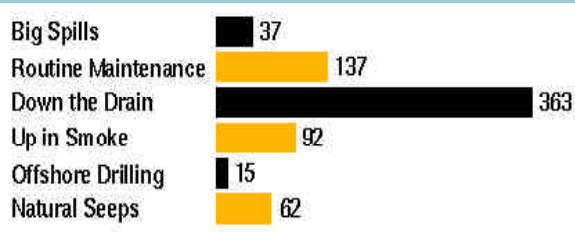


More than half of motorists do their own oil changes. It is important to recycle the used motor oil and filters from maintaining your vehicles, lawn equipment, or recreational vehicle.

Used motor oil contains toxic substances like lead produced during engine use. Dumping of used oil contaminates the ground, groundwater and surface water.

The EPA estimates that only half the oil from do-it-yourselfers is recycled. The rest is poured in the garbage, down the drain, into sewers, or on the ground.



This chart shows how many millions of gallons of oil each source puts into oceans worldwide each year.

Motor oil is very recyclable - it does not wear out, it just gets dirty. It might be refined and made into lubricating oils that meet the same specifications as non-recycled motor oil. Perhaps it will be processed and burned in special furnaces for heat, or used in power plants to generate electricity. If the oil generated by all do-it-yourself oil changers in America were collected and re-refined, it would provide enough motor oil for over 50 million cars each year.

Did you know?

One quart of used motor oil will foul the taste of 250,000 gallons of water and one pint of oil can create an acre size oil slick on surface water.

Used Oil Safety Tip #1

Drain your used oil into a container that will not deteriorate. Do not use a food or beverage container. Make sure the container is properly sealed when you bring it to be recycled.
