## **Post Smoke-free Air Law Public Opinion Survey**

HOWELL, Michigan. – (July 29, 2010) The Livingston County Department of Public Health (LCDPH), in collaboration with the Michigan Department of Community Health, is conducting a public opinion survey regarding the smoke-free legislation from Monday August 2<sup>nd</sup> until Friday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>.

The purpose of this survey is to assess knowledge, attitudes, and behaviors of Michigan residents after the Smoke-free Air law has been in effect for a period of 3 months. Since May 1, 2010, all worksites in Michigan are smoke-free with the exception of gaming floors of the Detroit casinos, exempted cigar bars, and tobacco specialty stores
