Smoke-free Air Law Public Opinion Survey

HOWELL, Michigan (March 9, 2010) Recently the Michigan Legislature passed state-wide, smoke-free workplace legislation. Effective May 1, 2010, all worksites in Michigan will be smoke-free with the exception of gaming floors of the Detroit casinos, exempted cigar bars, and tobacco specialty stores.

The Livingston County Department of Public Health (LCDPH), in collaboration with the Michigan Department of Community Health, is conducting a public opinion survey regarding the smoke-free legislation until Friday April 15th.
