- Friday, July 22** Superintendents will have cages, pens and stalls assigned and labeled with club names.

- Saturday, July 23** **Judging will take place in the Livestock Arena located north of the 4-H Building and between the Dairy Barn and the Horse Barn.**
9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. Judging of 4-H Animal Science, Photography, Creative Arts, Folk Art, Woodworking, Ceramics, Folkpatterns, Safety, Leisure Education and Sports, Electrical Science, Engines and Power, Computers, Rocketry, Clothing, Knitting, Crocheting, Needlecraft, Buymanship, Conservation, Entomology, Secretary’s Books, Treasurer’s Books, Teen Leadership, Self-Determined Exhibits, Fiber, 4-H Clover Buds (5-8 year olds), Vegetables, Flowers, Crops, Wheelbarrows, Scarecrows and Achievement Booths according to the Club Judging Schedule that appears in the pre-fair newsletter.
- 4-H Foods, Food Preservation and Cake Decorating will also be judged on Saturday, July 23 from 10 a.m. - 3 p.m. at the Gazebo in front of the 4-H Kitchen. Members can come anytime during judging time.** Exhibitors need to bring a 4-H Foods and Nutrition Evaluation/Recipe form with them to the judging for each project. Forms are available from your 4-H leader or the MSU Extension office. A standard photo of your food exhibit should accompany all food exhibits not left on display.
